Designed with versatility in mind, Florence comfortably sleeps up to six people, making her ideal for couples, families, or anyone looking to share their boating lifestyle with guests. The layout is cleverly arranged to offer both communal space and privacy, with the fixed double bedroom at the stern, bunk beds set mid-ship, and an L-shaped dinette that converts into an additional double berth in the saloon. The central passageway connects all areas of the boat while allowing for a natural flow and sense of space.

The forward saloon is the heart of the boat – a warm and inviting space perfect for relaxing after a day's cruising. The large L-shaped dinette seats several people comfortably for meals or games and effortlessly transforms into a bed for overnight guests. A multi-fuel stove adds a cosy touch, making this space a snug retreat year-round. Smart storage solutions are built into the seating and walls, keeping the area clutter-free and homely.

The galley kitchen sits just beyond the saloon and includes a gas oven, grill, hob, fridge, and stainless-steel sink, along with plenty of cupboards and drawers for cookware and provisions. Whether you're preparing a full evening meal or just a morning coffee, this space is functional and easy to use.

One of Florence's standout features is its two distinct bathroom areas – a rarity on narrowboats of this size. The first is a shower room with handbasin, while the second is a separate WC with handbasin. Located amidships, both bathrooms are conveniently positioned between the sleeping areas and day spaces, offering added comfort and privacy for all onboard.

At the rear of the boat, the fixed double bedroom is a peaceful sanctuary, featuring lockers, drawers, and generous hanging space. It also houses the hot water tank and electrical control locker, all neatly tucked away to maintain a tidy and organised interior. The midship bunk beds are perfect for children, guests, or extra storage when not in use.

Located just outside Devizes in Wiltshire, Caen Hill Marina is a peaceful and secure spot in the heart of the Kennet & Avon Canal network.
