The cosy lounge is warmed by a Stovax solid fuel stove, ideal for relaxing after a day on the water, and is complemented by handy built-in storage.

Towards the stern, the boatman's cabin doubles as a secondary bedroom with a let-down double bed, seating area, wardrobe, cupboards, and even a Panasonic radio for entertainment – all brought to life by a charming porthole window.
